Oxford, with its dreaming spires, academic community, thriving business life and large numbers of tourists, is also home to many people in need. A quarter of the city's population suffers significant financial hardship. Begging or sleeping on the streets are the obvious signs of poverty. Much more is hidden from view.

...the OxPAT response

Set up in 1996 by concerned citizens, representatives from the City, University, police and churches, and run by volunteers, OxPAT has raised over 100,000 pounds so far to alleviate visible and invisible poverty in Oxford.
